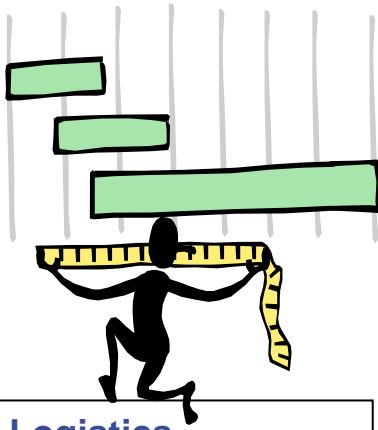




Professional Development Workshop Series: Data & Accountability in Your Schools

Data Management: Using the Progress Report and other Data in Your School Planning Process

Participants are introduced to the practices and principles of data management including – What does it mean? Who is involved? How do you establish and maintain good data systems in school? From this foundation, they begin to develop a deeper understanding of the Progress Report (PR), exploring how the PR is organized/structured, the different components that schools are measured on, how it is scored, and the impact of comparisons across peer schools and city schools.

- **Product/Takeaway:** A process/system for data collection, data verification and ensuring for accuracy, delivery and reporting, and school-wide accountability. Turnkey presentations to use at school.

Driving Data to the Classroom Level

By working with their own data, participants learn to: better analyze the trends and patterns of student performance in their schools; maximize the use of baseline and periodic assessments by drilling down to item skills analysis data; and organize/analyze information on a class level.

Note: you may bring teacher-leaders to join you on this day only.

- **Product/Takeaway:** Develop class *At-a-Glance* reports that include progress metrics, indicate students' mastery of the standards, and provides the foundation for creating targeted professional development to meet students' instructional needs.

Aligning the Data with School Program

Participants continue with the work from yesterday, and they move into aligning the data with programs in the school including curriculum planning, guidance and support, extended day, and teacher practice.

- **Product/Takeaway:** Process/system for engaging all stakeholders in improving student outcomes and “provider” accountability.
